PUPIL PREMIUM ELIGIBILITY School receives additional funding for pupils in receipt of free school meals, pupils who have parents serving in the armed forces or children looked after/previously looked after by the Local Authority.

You may be eligible for free school meals if you are in receipt of the following benefits:

- Job Seekers Allowance (income based)
- Pension Credit
- Employment & Support Allowance (income related)
- Child Tax Credits
- Universal Credit

Please note that you cannot get Free School Meals if you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit or receive fostering allowance.

MANDARIN CLUB AT THE QUEENS SCHOOL The Queen's School is a designated Confucius Classroom, a coveted accolade awarded in recognition of our excellent work in promoting the study of Mandarin. Every year we offer a free after-school Mandarin Club for Year 5 children from all primary schools as part of our outreach programme, and we would love your child to join us. The club starts after Christmas and is always extremely popular. Spaces are limited so we recommend you register as soon as possible if you want your son or daughter to be involved. It would be fantastic to see as many pupils as possible benefit from the wonderful opportunities, resources and expertise that come with our Confucius Classroom status. Activities include language learning, dance, music, crafts and learning about Chinese celebrations and culture. We very much believe that learning a new language can and should be fun! The club will start on Tuesday 9 January 2024 and will run weekly until the end of the summer term in July. Please note that no sessions will be held during The Queen's School holidays (please refer to our website for exact dates). Your child would need to be brought to The Queen's Senior School on City Walls Road for 4pm each week, where, after refreshments, all of our exciting activities begin. They will then need to be collected by 5pm.

We have had several students discover their love for Mandarin and go on to study the subject at GCSE, A-level and beyond!
