Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back and Happy New Year to you all!! It has been a great couple of days seeing the children looking so smart and happy in their learning.



LIONS PRIDE We are loving the pictures and comments that have been coming in for the Lion's Pride Award. We want to remind you that the first assessment window is Monday. Please get all evidence in by Monday 8th January so that it can be assessed throughout the week. If your child has achieved their Bronze Award, you will be invited in for a celebratory assembly soon.

Just a few reminders:

- TERM TIME HOLIDAYS If you wish to take your child on holiday during term time then please note: Cheshire West and Chester Council will issue a Fixed Penalty Notice. You must complete a holiday request form (available from the school office) which we will then review. Holidays are only granted if the circumstances of the requested leave are 'exceptional'. If they are not deemed as 'exceptional', and you still choose to take a holiday with your child during this period (meaning the absence is classed as unauthorised), the Local Authority will be informed. A Fixed Penalty Notice will then be issued in accordance with section 444 of the Education Act 1996. This will lead to a charge of £60 per child per parent.
- **STAFF CAR PARK** Please do not park in the staff car park at any time. The school carpark is only to be used by our staff, for health and safety reasons with our reception children as they use the main doors at pick up and drop off times.
- **ABSENCE** If your child is off poorly or absent for any reason then you must inform the school office before 9am. If your child is off for longer than one day, please leave a message daily. Please leave a message on the pupil absence line (option I).
- **MEDICATION** If your child requires medication during school hours, please hand this in to the school office and complete a medication form. We will not administer any prescribed medication without the correct box and information. If your child is asthmatic, please ensure we have up-to-date inhalers.
- **HEADBUMPS** If your child bumps their head/face during the school day we will send you either a text, smart message or email to inform you stating how it happened and what first aid was carried out. This is not to alarm you but more as a courtesy message so that you can continue to monitor your child at home and seek medical advice if required.
- LOST PROPERTY Please ensure that your child's name is clearly marked on items such as coats, jumpers and cardigans. If your child loses an item then please search the lost property bin in the school hall at the end of the day. We have so many garments not being claimed. We will keep for up to a month but then we will put in recycling if there is no name.
- **PE** Children are to come to school on their allocated PE days in their normal PE kit (white t-shirt, black shorts, plain black pumps/trainers). We recommend that children wear black tracksuit/jogging bottoms and top in case of poor weather and to keep warm in the classroom during the colder months. A lot of children are arriving in designer non-

school uniform clothing for PE which is not to be worn. Please do check that they are wearing the correct uniform and footwear. Children must also come to school wearing a coat.

SWIMMING In the next couple of weeks you will receive a letter about the new swimming provision. Lessons will be taking place on site this year with the only requirement from home being appropriate swimming costume and swimming hat. The hat is very important for our pool and must be worn. If you are struggling buying a swimming hat, we can sell them from school at £3 each. Full information for each year group will be sent to you when all timetables have been completed so do please watch out for the letter coming home.

RESIDENTIAL TRIPS Please ensure you are on track with your payment plans for these trips. All monies are payable on School Spider.
