system. Parents from Year I upwards will be familiar with this easy-to-use system and know how great it is to have control over pre-ordering your child's dinners and also having access to check your account balance and to pay online. If you choose not to pre-order then this will be done during morning registration in each class as we currently do so. Please note: we will start using this system from Monday Ist November 2021.

DINNER DEBTS A text will be sent to all parents on Friday 15th October to highlight any debts on your current



dinner accounts. This final payment **MUST BE PAID IN CASH** to the school office by Monday 18th October as the School Spider payment options will be disabled from this date. Final cash payments must also include any lunches that your child will be having in the final week of half term. Please bring correct cash.
