REHEARSAL All pupils in Key Stage 2 will be going to The Ellesmere Port Church of England College on Tuesday 7th December to rehearse for their upcoming winter performance. Children will be transported to TEPCEC either by minibus or staff cars, leaving school between 11:45am-12:45pm, therefore KS2 pupils will only be able to have a packed lunch or picnic bag this day, no hot dinners will be available.

We are requesting that as many children as possible get picked up from TEPCEC (main entrance at the front) at 3pm. This will give you chance to then drive to Rossmore to collect any siblings in KSI at 3:15pm. If your child gets the school bus home or is in Tiny Tots, then we will bring them back to Rossmore. If your child is taking part in the pupil vs parent netball match at Rossmore, we will also bring them back to school.

Please complete the permission form on School Spider to confirm home time & lunch arrangements. This must be completed by Monday 6th December or we will assume you are collecting from TEPCEC.

IMPORTANT UPDATE: We have been advised by TEPCEC that all parents MUST wear a face covering whilst watching the performance, unless exempt. All parents are also advised that you must take a Lateral Flow Test 24hrs before the performance and can only attend with a negative result. We trust that parents will follow this guidance in order for the performance to take place and to keep our school community as safe as possible.

MEDICATION If your child requires medication during the school day the medicine must come in to school in the original packaging with the prescription label clearly stating their name and the correct dosage. Without this we are unable to administer medication to your child.
