**Dear Parents** 

We break up on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December at 1:30pm for the Christmas Holidays, returning on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2022. **All children are to be collected promptly at 1:30pm; there will be no school bus home this day.** 

**COVID UPDATE** With the Prime Minister putting 'Plan B' in place could I please remind all parents and carers to wear a face covering during drop off/pick up and whilst in the school building. We will continue to keep this under review and keep you updated with any changes.

**PARKING** I am so sad and appalled by the behaviour and language that took place at the front of school this morning. Parking is difficult I know but I do expect all parents to behave appropriately in front of the children and using such aggression both verbally and physically is totally unacceptable!

Could I please remind all parents not to park in front of our neighbours' drives, or indeed in dangerous areas, as it would be devastating if something serious was to happen. It would be far safer to park your car just a little further away and walk the rest of the way to the school gates. We do not want to have the PCSO's involved again but I will be left with no choice if this behaviour continues.

**SUPERMARKET VOUCHERS** If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, Cheshire West and Chester Council have provided funding for supermarket vouchers to cover the Christmas holiday period. A voucher from 'Evouchers.com' worth £70 has been emailed to you and is only to be used to purchase food and drink items for your child to cover this 2-week period. Reminder: We have been advised by TEPCEC that **all parents MUST** wear a face covering whilst watching the performance, unless exempt (proof of exemption will be needed as you arrive at TEPCEC). If you forget to bring one, we will have disposable face masks available. All parents are also advised to take a Lateral Flow Test 24hrs before the performance and can only attend with a negative result. We trust that parents will follow this guidance in order for the performance to take place and to keep our school community as safe as possible.

ATTENDANCE CONCERNS It has come to my attention that a number of parents are not happy with one of our attendance initiatives. I would therefore like to clarify that we are doing everything we can to support good attendance across the school which I feel very strongly needs to be led by the children and yourselves as parents. We do therefore have the attendance league, as you can see below, which the children love and look forward to every week. This really supports a team approach helping children to encourage each other leading to positive attitudes around school attendance.

We have in the past used a whole school 100% achievement as another way to encourage children to come in to school every day, unless it really is impossible due to Doctors' appointments, sickness and diarrhoea etc. as we have been told by many parents that they have difficulties some days with children saying they are tired or have an upset tum, to name but a few.

Obviously we want to help parents by teaching children resilience and perseverance and see attendance in the same way. When we check for 100% attendance we look at each child individually so that we don't penalise children for time off that could not have been avoided. Unfortunately, we cannot include sickness/diarrhoea in this exemption as, whilst this may be a valid reason, it may also, sadly, not be a valid reason. Although this may seem unfair, we as a school want to celebrate the efforts of children and families and see this initiative as an opportunity which we will therefore be continuing.
