SCHOOL SPIDER UPDATE

From **Tuesday 17th June** your username for your School Spider login will be replaced by the email address linked to your account.

Great news, if you have children in two schools you will no longer need to login and out, your accounts will automatically be linked.

What do I need to do?

When you login from **Tuesday 17th June** to School Spider, use your **email address** as your username. The password will remain the same.

If you have your username/password combination saved on any browsers, you will need to update this.

We've heard from School Spider that they're experiencing a bit of a glitch with payments and club bookings right now. They're working hard to get everything sorted as quickly as possible!

In the meantime, if you're making a card payment, they've suggested trying **Apple Pay or Google Pay** if that's an option for you.
